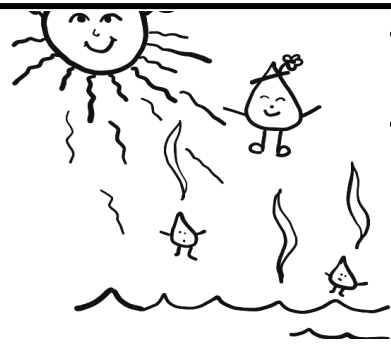

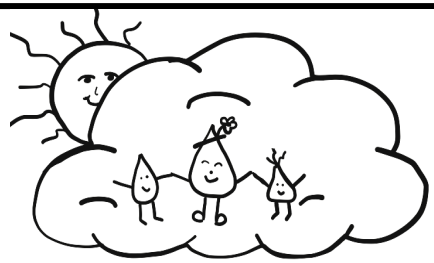
Waverly The Water droplet



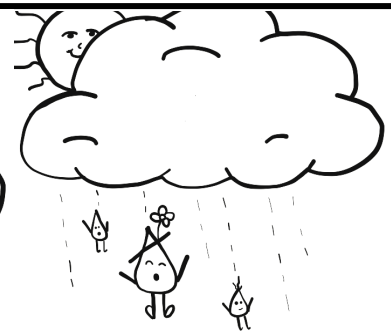
Many water droplets make up a lake.



The sun heats the water and causes evaporation.

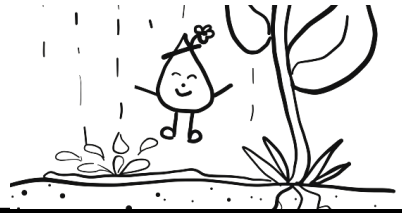


The water droplets bond together to form clouds.

Precipitation can fall as rain, providing water for plants and animals. Droplets may then complete the cycle by being evaporated or flowing into a river or lake.

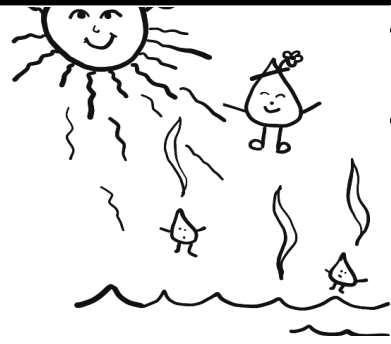
